### RETENTION RATE

Percentage of students who started on the enrollment date (who began Paramedic coursework) who are enrolled, graduated, or stopped-out (i.e., reasonably expected to re-enroll at a later date).

### 100% On-time Program Completion Rate (calculated annually)

On-time program completion rate is defined as the number of students who complete the program on-schedule within a cohort compared to the number who enrolled in the cohort initially (defined as beginning at the first semester of class including general education courses).

### ANNUAL CREDENTIALING EXAMS

Credentialing examination pass rate is defined as the number of graduates who pass the professional credentialing examination on first attempt compared with the number of graduates within that cohort who took the examination. (NATIONAL REGISTRY OF EMTs) THIS SHOWS THE RESULTS OF THE COHORT FOR THE GRADUATING YEAR.

**JOB PLACEMENT RATES**

Job placement rate is defined as the number of graduates employed in the PARAMEDIC field, within twelve months of graduation, compared to the number of graduates actively seeking employment in the PARAMEDIC field.
