Individuals who request a shadowing opportunity are required to be fully vaccinated for Covid-19 prior to the experience. Proof of vaccination status must be provided in order to participate.

DIAGNOSTIC MEDICAL SONOGRAPHY

The Diagnostic Medical Sonography Shadow Program provides individuals with an opportunity to shadow ultrasound technologists and observe ultrasound procedures firsthand in Reading Hospital's Radiology Department or observe Diagnostic Medical Sonography courses in the classroom and/or lab environment at the Reading Hospital School of Health Sciences.

Shadowing experiences at Reading Hospital's Radiology Department are scheduled on Tuesdays from 1 to 3:30 p.m., and Thursdays from 9 to 11:30 a.m. Observations in classes at the Reading Hospital School of Health Sciences are scheduled as availability permits.

Program Requirements

- Must be at least 16 years of age or older.
- If under 18, required parent/guardian consent form for shadowing needs to be completed.
- Photo identification and proof of age is required for ALL observers.
- Appropriate attire must be followed.
- Provide proof of COVID-19 vaccination.

MEDICAL IMAGING

Medical Imaging Program applicants can get a closer look at the profession by spending a few hours observing medical imaging professionals and procedures firsthand in various areas of Reading Hospital's Radiology Department. Shadowing experiences are scheduled weekly during morning hours. As availability allows, alternate scheduling outside of this timeframe can be accommodated.

Shadowing Requirements

- Interest in seeking enrollment in the RHSHS MI Program
- 16 years of age or older
- If under age 18, parent/guardian consent form
- Photo identification and proof of age
- Appropriate attire – guidelines will be provided
- Confidentiality Agreement
- Proof of COVID-19 vaccination

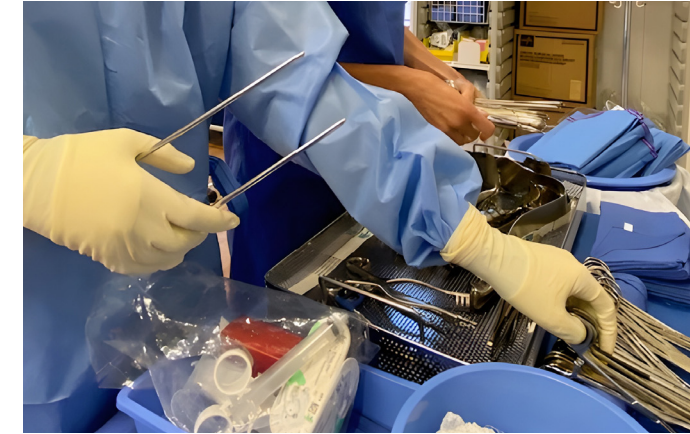
Schedule for the Day

SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY

Individuals interested in finding out more about careers related to the Operating Room will have the opportunity to shadow a Surgical Technologist in the Operating Room environment during a surgical procedure.

Shadowing experiences take place at Reading Hospital from 8 to 11:30 a.m., Monday through Friday.

Program Requirements

- Be at least 16 years of age or older.
- If under age 18, the parent/guardian consent form must be signed.
- Possess a photo identification.
- Provide proof of current Influenza vaccination.
- Provide proof of COVID-19 vaccination.
