If you're considering a career in nursing and would like an up-close look at what nurses do on a daily basis, consider the **Discover Nursing Summer Program** offered by Reading Hospital School of Health Sciences.

This experience is designed to give prospective nursing students an opportunity to work with nurses within Reading Hospital. You may get a chance to spend time in one of the state's busiest emergency departments and observe nurses working in maternity, pediatrics, or medical-surgical areas.

Dates and Times of Discover Program:

In order for the School and Hospital to provide successful experiences, sessions must be arranged during weeks when Hospital staff and resources are available. Program details will be made available at a later date.

Program Requirements

The **Discover Nursing Summer Program** is open to students entering either junior or senior year of high school and who have a GPA of 3.0 or greater, verified by an official high school transcript.

Students wishing to participate in the program must verify good school attendance and punctuality, and immunizations, as well as present a health clearance form and two letters of recommendation by a person who is qualified to verify academic ability.

Lunch and uniform scrubs will be provided to each applicant.



All materials must be received by the Admissions Office by March 31, prior to the start of the program.

Program Availability

In order to assure that participants receive the full benefit of the **Discover Nursing Summer Program**, the number of participants is limited to 12. Selection of qualified applicants is made on a first-come, first-serve basis.
